I look forward to seeing you at some of the upcoming events over the next two weeks.




# CERTIFICATE ASSEMBLEY

Thank you to our community for taking the time to fill in the Health Curriculum Survey. There is an overwhelming response that the health curriculum and initiatives we cover and provide are of high priority to parents and caregivers.

The community posted many positive comments about what we cover and Riverdale School will continue to provide a broad range of health initiatives. The top three initiatives that the community would like us to concentrate on over the next two years are:

- 1 Hauora Emotional and Mental Well Being (48.5%)
- 2 Water Safety (38.8%)
- 3 Cyber Safety (32 %)

It is also clear that Sexual Education - Navigating Sexuality will need to be further unpacked with the community over the next two years so we are clear and concise before implementing it in the classroom.
