WELCOME JOSIE CARSON



This week our Poutama and Pounamu Atawhai teams took part in a Water Safety programme run by Coach Craig from Kelly's Sports. With so many unfortunate tragedies in and around New Zealand waterways over the last few summers, we aim to ensure our tamariki have some knowledge of where and when it is safe to swim as well as some survival techniques they could use in an emergency. The children have practised floating in different positions and learnt to swim using less exerting swimming strokes. Coach Craig brought life jackets along for the children to learn how to correctly wear them and they also practised using other floatation devices.
